EVACUATIONS ORDERED FOR LA CANADA FLINTRIDGE AND LA CRESCENTA

Evacuation orders have been issued today (Friday, February 19) by the Foothills Incident Unified Command for 188 residences in La Canada Flintridge and La Crescenta due to the possibility of debris flows resulting from forecast rain storms in the area.

Residents are urged to follow the evacuation orders as a safety precaution. Evacuations must be completed by 4:00 p.m. today.

The Red Cross has established an evacuation shelter at the La Canada Presbyterian Church at 626 Foothill Boulevard in La Canada. The shelter will open at 4:00 p.m.

Affected property owners are being notified of the evacuation orders by the LA County Sheriff's Department. They include 146 residences in La Canada Flintridge and 42 in La Crescenta.

'No Parking During Rain Event' restrictions will also be enforced on posted streets in La Canada Flintridge and La Crescenta. Parking will not be allowed on those streets during the entire rain event.
